### What do I do to become an official?

The following steps can get you started by visiting PIAA.org and ...

1. **Read up on some Frequently Asked Questions**

There are a few things you may need to know about officiating sports in Pennsylvania. This guide will fill you in on the details.

2. **Fill out the downloadable Application Form** at PIAA.org web site. Fill in the blanks to tell us a bit about yourself.

3. **Mail us your application with a \$30 check**

4. **Read up on Rules of Competition**

Before you take the test, you may want to freshen up on the sports you wish to officiate. In some cases your local official's chapter will conduct training classes to help prepare you for the PIAA Officials Examination and on field training to prepare you for the season.

5. **Pass the PIAA Officials' Examination**

We test your knowledge to make sure you know the rules! Test dates are Monday February 3, 2014, Monday June 2, 2014 and Monday October 6, 2014. You may test at any of the locations in the state. Visit PIAA.org for the site in your area.
