Thank you for hosting PIAA District III Field Hockey.

1. The only passes accepted are a White District III pass and a Gold Lifetime pass.
2. You will be contacted with the schools playing at your site and the officials assigned for the site.
3. Contact each school playing at your site to confirm date, time, uniforms and any special requests.
4. Home team will be the higher seed. They will wear white jerseys and white socks. Visiting team is the lower seed. They will wear dark jerseys and dark socks. (example #4 vs. #13, #4 seed is home, #13 seed is visitor)
5. The visiting team will call the coin toss.
6. Each team must provide 5 new top quality orange balls and 5 new top quality white balls or 5 new top quality yellow balls (officials will choose ball color), two line/ball runners, and a table clock. Official time will be kept on the table but it must correspond to the time on the scoreboard. The scoreboard will run to 0:00 and the game ends on the horn, with the exception of a penalty corner, when necessary. The penalty corner will end on the official's whistle.
7. Alternate/table official will be the official score/time keeper.
8. Teams will be given a minimum of 20 minutes, or up until scheduled game time, for warm ups on the game field. Example: 5 PM game ends in regulation time, teams will warm up until 7 PM start time; 5 PM game goes into strokes, at conclusion of strokes, teams will receive 20 minutes warm up until the introduction of line ups and start of the next game.
9. Tie breaker will be (1) 15 minute reduced player-sudden victory, (2) 15 minute reduced player-sudden victory, (3) set of 5 penalty strokes, (4) set of 5 penalty strokes, (5) penalty strokes - sudden victory
- 10.. Conduct a pre-game meeting with school administrators and officials.
11. Make sure there is a trainer on site. The trainer may be assigned by you or provided by one of the teams.
12. Call/text/email scores to Dave Bitting, at conclusion of each contest.
13. Report scores to Harrisburg Patriot News 1-800-692-7207. They will want to know the official scoring information.
14. No body paint, artificial noise makers, whistles, horns, etc. are permitted at District III events. Stationary signs that are not negative, derogatory or offensive are permitted at District III events.
15. All financial reports must be returned to Bob Baker, District III Treasurer

Financial Management: All rounds \$6 adults, \$4 students (K - 12)
Each school is allowed five complimentary admissions

Payment Schedule: Officials - \$88 per game, Alternate/table official -\$44 per game
Game Managers - \$80 single, \$150 double header, \$200 triple header
Trainers - \$50 single, \$80 double header, \$100 triple header
