Enclosed please review the regulations, brackets, and other important information for participation in the 2017 District III M&T Bank Girls Volleyball Championships. The tournament will consist of four classifications with all teams qualifying and seeded based on District III Power Ranking System within each respective classification. Teams must play at least 11 contests to qualify for the tournament.

>Games Played Through October 20, 2017 Count Toward District Power Ranking< (Only non-tournament contests & best of five tournament contests will be calculated.)

Format: (NFHS Rules will apply)

- Tournament matches will be single elimination.
- Semifinal losers in 3A & 4A will play for 3rd place. District III qualifies three teams states in 3A and in 4A
- There will be no 3rd Place contests in Class 1A or Class 2A since District III only receives two slots in the PIAA Championships for Class 1A and one slot in the PIAA Championships for Class 2A.
- The HIGHER seeded team will be designated the Home Team throughout the tournament.
- Rally scoring will be used for all District III matches.
- Contests will be played as double-header matches at the site of the higher seeded team through the quarterfinals.
- All single elimination matches will be the best of five games. Each of the first four games will be played to 25 points with the tie-breaking fifth game played to 15 points.
- Each team is required to provide a game ball for each of its matches.
- The Baden Perfection VX5EC-210 Volleyball is the only ball which may be used after the opening rounds. Because of this requirement, the District will provide a game ball to each school that advances beyond the opening round.
- There will be no warm-ups on adjoining courts while a game is in progress.
- An Official Scorer and Libero Tracker will be supplied by the site's Game Manager.
- The District III Committee will alter established game times to avoid conflicts with school graduation, baccalaureate, and state or federal testing.

Warm-up Procedures

The following warm-up procedure is the only accepted format to be followed for the District III Girls Volleyball Tournament;

*Single Matches: 20 minutes (6-7-7)

>20 minutes: 6 shared, 7 serving team, 7 receiving team.

Admission Prices

The admission price will remain the same for **all** rounds of the tournament.

Adults = \$6 & Students = \$4

>Only District III Passes are accepted. However, each site will admit up to five (5) participating school representatives free of charge. Schools participating must utilize the "Comp List" provided by the Game Manager.

Sportsmanship

Banners, hand held signs, or noisemakers of any type are not permitted at District III events. Menacing actions and gestures toward opposing players or officials will not be tolerated. Please stress positive support for the participants.

State Tournament

Three schools from Class AAAA, three schools from Class AAA, one school from Class AA, and two schools from Class A will advance to the State Tournament.
