

# 2012-2013 District 3 Competitive Spirit Championship

## Conditions of Entry

Entry and participation into the 2012 Competitive Spirit Championship is voluntary. There will be a \$75 dollar registration fee for this year's Championship. Entry of a team signifies that the member school accepts the conditions and provisions that are described below. Furthermore, a member school accepts the fact that the cheerleading chair reserves the right to make changes in the management and operation of the championship, if deemed necessary.

## General Directions

The championship is scheduled for 12/15/12 at Central Dauphin East High School in Harrisburg. The championship will be open to all PIAA D-3 schools. This competition is open only to the varsity competition squads from each school. The Universal Cheerleaders Association will be providing the judges. NFHS and UCA rules will govern the competition. We will use the same scoring sheet as the PIAA State Competition. Once that score sheet becomes available I will get it out to everyone. Each squad will have 2.5 minutes for their performance in the following divisions: Small Division (5-15 females), Medium Division (16-20 females), Large Division (21-30 females), and Coed (5-30 females and males). One male would place you in the Co-Ed division for this event. There will be 15 medals given in the small division, 20 in the medium division, 30 in the large division, and 30 in the Co-Ed division. This event will take place on a cheer floor and the top 2 teams in each division will be recognized. There is no individual jump off/tumble off for this event.

Teams must enter this competition to be eligible to compete in the PIAA State Competition. District 3 will qualify a total of 15 teams for the PIAA State Competition. District 3 will advance the champions, runner-up's, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams in the small, medium, and large divisions as well as the next 6 highest scores, no matter which division, with the exception of Co-Ed. The state is not taking any Co-Ed teams into the tournament this year. Teams may enter one division, small through large plus the Co-Ed division, if you have a boy(s) competing. This will allow you to qualify a girls' team for the PIAA State Competition. There will be an additional \$25.00 fee if you are going to enter in the Co-Ed division in addition to another division. If there are not at least 3 teams in a division that division will be cancelled. If a division is cancelled that team will have the opportunity to qualify for the State competition.

Teams entering the championship may send their registration and entry fee, payable to PIAA District Three, to Adam Sheaffer, Greenwood H.S., 405 E. Sunbury St., Millerstown PA, 17062. All entry form should be received by noon on Nov. 16<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Once I have a tentative number of schools I will create a schedule for the day.
