## **Report of the Treasurer**

A second hearing was held at the request of Delone on the transfer of Logan Brown from Hanover. Delone was represented by Principal Richard La Rocca, Athletic Director Tim Bonitz, Football coach Corey Zortman, Mr. & Mrs. Brown and Logan. On a motion by Greg Goldthorp with a second from Doug Bohannon eligibility for football was denied on a vote of 15-0. Eligibility was approved for other sports.
