### **Report of the Secretary**

The Dec. 12 minutes were approved as presented on a motion by Mike Clair with a second from Hal Griffiths.

### **Report of the Treasurer**

A listing of all checks for December thru January 31 was provided. A summary of all fall sports income and expenses was provided and reviewed. The report was accepted on a motion by Tory Harvey with a second from Greg Goldthorp

### **Eligibility Considerations**

Approvals for the last month were reviewed.

The hearing between Dallastown and Eastern York to determine the eligibility of Jase Graybill was cancelled at the request of Eastern York and Jase was determined to be eligible by Dallastown.

At a special meeting on January 22 the Committee held a hearing to determine the eligibility of Edward Wells who had transferred from Gettysburg to Northern York.
