- Schools were reminded that ticket requests for this fall must be received by August 1.
- Discussion was held on increasing broadcast fees but a motion by Doug Bohannon with a second from Tory Harvey was passed to keep fees as they are now but not permit Live Streaming.
- Boys & Girls Tennis District entries in 3A were increased from 8 to 10 on a motion by Doug Bohannon with a second from Tory Harvey.
- Rod Frisco was given permission to solicit ads for the District Programs on a motion by Dave Bitting with a second from Adam Sheaffer.
- With increased expenses and decreased attendance all Sport Chairmen are asked to look at ways to cut costs without harming the program.
